

RESOLUTION NO. 2018.16

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST VALLEY WATER DISTRICT APPROVING AND ADOPTING A LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Proposition 84, the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (“Prop 84”), requires Awarding Agencies utilizing funds for public works projects derived from that act to initiate and enforce a labor compliance program (“LCP”) as described in subdivision (b) of Section 1771.5 of the Labor Code; and

WHEREAS, the East Valley Water District (“District”) has applied for, and intends to utilize funds derived from one or more such State Bond Acts for certain public works projects, including the Sterling Natural Resource Center; and

WHEREAS, the East Valley Water District wishes to make a written finding that it has initiated and shall enforce, a Labor Compliance Program as described in subdivision (b) of Section 1771.5 of the Labor Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of East Valley Water District as follows:

Section 1. East Valley Water District hereby adopts, for implementation, the attached Department of Industrial Relations approved Labor Compliance Program.

Section 2. East Valley Water District shall contract with Golden State Labor Compliance, an approved third party provider, to initiate and enforce the above mentioned Labor Compliance Program on behalf of East Valley Water District as required by Labor Code Section 1771.8.
